Photo Contest Official Rules

1. Contest Timelines and Voting

The submission period for images to be entered into the contest begins at 12am on February 15th, 2023 and ends at 11:59pm on March 23rd, 2023.

Winners will be chosen by votes cast by general attendees in person at the Edible Earth Fest event taking place on March 25th, 2023. Vote casting will be conducted electronically via personal devices using a dedicated link available at the event. An onsite terminal will also be available to attendees whom wish to vote via the terminal.

Winners (i.e. Overall Winner and Winners in Each Category) will be determined by total votes cast by 12pm on March 25th, 2023.

2. Photo Contest Categories

Prizes will be awarded for top photos in each of the following categories:

- A. Homegrown Harvest (i.e. Fruits or Veggies)
- B. Interesting Insects or Wildlife Found in Missouri City
- C. Flowers from the Garden or Native Habitat
- D. Unusual Gardening Methods or Setups
- E. Birds and Birdhouses

Each person may submit up to 4 photos per category.

- For use in the promotion of future photo contests hosted by MCG
